1. PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct for age grade players (Under the age of 18) must be followed by all age grade players who are members of Doncaster RFC (the "Club") and support the Club, its coaches and other age grade rugby volunteers in applying the Code.

Any age grade player who appears to be in breach of the Code of Conduct for age grade players may be the subject of Club disciplinary procedures which could ultimately lead to suspension or withdrawal of Club membership in respect of the age grade player involved.

Youth players at the Club are encouraged to:

- recognise and appreciate the efforts made by their coaches, parents, match officials and other age grade volunteers in providing the opportunity for them to play the game and enjoy the rugby environment.
- understand the values of loyalty and commitment to their squad and Club.
- recognise that they and all other age grade rugby players have the right to expect their involvement in rugby to be free from all types of abuse.
- understand that if they or other age grade rugby players feel they are not being treated in a manner that is acceptable, they have a right to tell an adult at the Club or outside the game.
